<p><u>H.S.E. approved First Aid at Work (FAAW) Course - THS87</u></p>
<p>Certificate valid for three years, then a 12hr (2 day) requalification course will be necessary to maintain the qualification.</p> <p>Designed for those working in an area with higher hazards and/or large numbers of people. Offers training which covers the majority of injuries/illnesses that may happen in the workplace.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> - 18hrs (3 days) 9.15am – 4.30pm</p>
<p><u>H.S.E. approved Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW) Course - THS119</u></p>
<p>A new course arising from the HSE guidelines which came into being on the 1st October 2009. Certificate valid for three years, then the course will need to be repeated to maintain the qualification.</p> <p>The Emergency First Aid at Work qualification is designed to offer appropriate training for those who will be offering First Aid cover in lower hazard working environments such as offices, shops and libraries.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> - 6hrs (1 day) 9.15am – 4.30pm</p>
<p><u>H.S.E. approved First Aid at Work Requalification Course - THS88</u></p>
<p>A requirement for those who hold the 3 day FAW certificate. To be done every three years to maintain qualification</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> - 12hrs (2 days) 9.15am – 4.30pm</p>
<p><u>First Aid annual refresher training - THS120</u></p>
<p>From 1st October 2009 this will be a requirement for those holding a HSE qualification (FAAW or EFAW) at the University of Manchester.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Covers use and practise of the recovery position, CPR and the treatment of bleeding.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> - 3hrs (Either 9.30am – 12.30pm or 1.30pm – 4.30pm)</p>
<p><u>First Aid awareness - THS112</u></p>
<p>Information on managing an emergency incident at the University of Manchester. Includes how to get help (first aider or ambulance), and the use of (and practise of) the recovery position.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> – 1.5hrs (arranged as required)</p>
<p><u>First Aid awareness and Basic Life Support - THS86</u></p>
<p>Information on managing an emergency incident, contacting help (first aider or ambulance), use of recovery position and CPR, practise of same.</p> <p>Would be suitable for persons appointed within the workplace to take care of first aid arrangements.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> - 3hrs (Either 9.30am – 12.30pm or 1.30pm – 4.30pm)</p>
<p><u>Specialised Burns - THS96</u></p>
<p>A course looking at specific hazards associated with hydrofluoric acid, phenol, cryogenic substances and other chemicals. Not just for first aiders (although a useful “bolt-on course” for those first aiders working in a hazardous environment), but for anyone working with these products.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Can be run as a bespoke session for specific departments.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> – usually 2hrs</p>
<p><u>Resuscitation update - THS111</u></p>
<p>Recovery position and CPR update only. Usually attended by medical staff</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> – usually 3hrs</p>
<p><u>Bespoke first aid session – THS122</u></p>
<p>It is also possible to arrange short training courses around a specific subject area e.g. diabetes or epilepsy.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">This is arranged on request</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Duration</u> – tba</p>
