The theme for the festival will be *Prevention and Screening*. Abstract submission does not have to be confined to this subject and there will be no weighting applied to this topic when abstracts are chosen.

Prizes will be given out for the best presentations and posters

Instructions

- 1. The work described should be related to public health.
- 2. Type the summary in black and give it a structure. It should be no longer than 250 words.
- 3. The title (typed in capital letters) should be followed by the name(s) and contact details of the author(s), with the presenting author underlined.
- 4. The summary should show the work's relevance to promoting health. The content should be an appropriate structure (e.g. aims, design, setting, participants, results and conclusions). Please indicate your preference for oral or poster presentation (or both).
- 5. The Manchester Medical Society Public Health Forum will select the work to feature at the meeting and will decide whether it is accepted for oral or poster presentation.
- 6. Your summary should reach us no later than **Friday 8th June 2012**.
