Please note when choosing the course units you wish to take you must ensure you choose:

- a maximum of 70 credits per semester
- no more and no less credits than stated from each list
- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject (CAHE/SOAN; SALC11012 may be included as a CAHE-coded unit). If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.
