### Understanding a Course Code

Courses within the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures include:

Each code is broken into four letters identifying the subject area and 5 numbers which identify both the Level (year of study) and the Semester the course unit is offered in.

The first numerical digit in the code shows the Level it is taught at:

- 1 = First year
- 2 = Second year
- 3 = Third year

You should usually take course units which correspond with your current year of study e.g. second years take 2\*\*\*\* numbered course units and final year students take 3\*\*\*\* course units.

The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code

- 0 = Year Long course (Course runs from the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014 – 08<sup>th</sup> May 2015)
- 1 = First semester (Course runs from the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014 – 12<sup>th</sup> December 2015)
- 2 = Second semester (Course runs from the 26<sup>th</sup> January 2015 – 08<sup>th</sup> May 2015)

You will be directed to your My Manchester Home Page

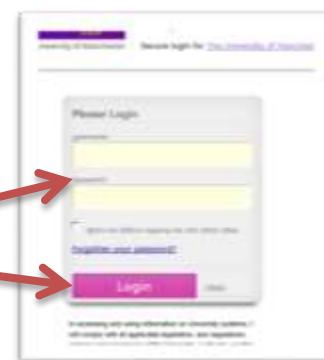
Select the **My Learning** tab and scroll down to view 'Course Unit Information'

You can also search for any course unit within the University, for example, to find a course you wish to take as a free choice.

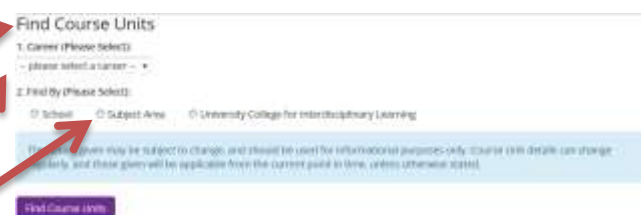
