



## **Council Tax**

### What is Council Tax?

Council Tax is a system of taxation on your accommodation students\*\*: made by the government and collected by your council. It Unfortunately there is no reduction in Council Tax and the pays for services such as waste collection, street lighting, full amount is due. Your living situation may also affect your eligibility for council tax exemption and you may be required to pay some council tax.

### I am a full-time student and I live in Halls of Residence.

### I am a full-time student and I live with other students (aged 18 or over) in a privately rented/owned property:

The property will be exempt from paying Council Tax however everyone in the household will need to inform the Council of their student status.

### I am a full-time student and I live with a non-student\*\*.

# where do I get this?

All students are issued with a confirmation of attendance letter as a PDF attachment to their University e-mail address after completing registration at the start of the academic year. Full-time students can use this letter as evidence of their eligibility for council tax exemption.
