



Conferences & Venues Team Sustainability Policy

The University of Manchester Conferences and Venues team are committed to embedding sustainability across all its operations. The University of Manchester's 2020 strategy has a key goal of: Social Responsibility, with Environmental Sustainability being a key player. This policy is part of the University's Environmental Sustainability Plan.

Conferences and Venues has specific impacts and opportunities that can help it adapt to climate change and help its operations reduce the impact it has on resource use, greenhouse gas emissions and support the enhancement of biodiversity in order for the business operation to continue whilst responding and adapting to the changes required.

Commitment to sustainability will be met through observing the three pillars of sustainability. These are: environmental impact, social responsibility and economic stability. The priority areas for improvements across the business will be through resource efficiency, engagement for all stakeholders, sustainable procurement and supporting habitat conservation and restoration where possible.

- Smart Investment: To explore future smart sustainable investments which reduce costs, ensure long term economic success, and continue our quality service for the future.

This policy addresses all areas of our business operations including Conference venues, Chancellors Hotel and the Chancellors collection and ConferCare (the University's event management team).

The Conferences and Venues Sustainability Action Plan sets out the strategy for managing and reducing the environmental impact of the business.
