- The following chemicals are category 1 and require a licence:

1-phenyl-2-propanone (BMK)
3-4 Methyleneoxy-Phenylpropan-2-one (PMK)
Alpha-phenylacetonitrile (APAAN)
Chloroephedrine
Chloropseudoephedrine
Ephedrine
Ergometrine
Ergotamine
Isosafrole
Lysergic Acid
N-acetylanthranilic Acid
Norephedrine
Piperonal
Pseudoephedrine
Safrole
4-anilino-N-phenethylpiperidine (ANPP)—NEW!!
N-phenethyl-4-piperidone (NPP)—NEW!!

- The following chemicals are category 2 and require registration if quantities (shown in brackets) are exceeded per year:

Acetic Anhydride (100litre)
Phenylacetic acid (1kg)
Potassium Permanganate (100kg)
Anthranilic acid (1kg)
Piperidine (0.5Kg)
