# Hallsworth Conference Fund

The Hallsworth endowment funds a number of outstanding academic conferences each year.

## Who's eligible?

Conference convenors should be employees of the University of Manchester. The event must be based in Manchester and all marketing and publicity material linked to the event must acknowledge the funding support provided by the Hallsworth endowment. The fund encourages some level of co-funding and/or external investment and collaboration with other organisations.

## What's funded?

Conferences should be landmark events that draw together a wide network of international researchers tackling major issues that are likely to have a lasting and significant research impact.

The fund encourages applications around the following areas of importance for the Humanities:

- Global inequalities
- China and international relations
- Health and wellbeing

#### Eligible costs

- Travel and subsistence
- Consumables including equipment, e.g. venue hire, printing

### Ineligible costs

Staff costs, indirect and estate costs

## How to apply

Applications open in late October and close in late January. Please check the website for deadlines. Colleagues should discuss their plans with their School Research Director to ensure that the proposal is aligned with the School's research priorities and is consistent with the spirit of the Hallsworth fund.

Colleagues should liaise with their School Research Office to prepare the budget before submitting an application.
