<b>Scope and content</b>	This collection mainly covers Kushnick's work in race relations including articles he has published, correspondence and research he has undertaken. Notable items include the 95 digital recordings that cover Lou's interest in the politics of the USA and racial polarisation of the late 1980's-2000. These recordings include interviews of key politicians, academics and community leaders in New York, Boston and Chicago such as Lu Palmer; Angelo Falcón; Paul Robeson Jr; Roger Wilkins; Rome Pucinski; Adjoa Aiyetora; Bernardine Dohrn; Dr Quentin Young and Hayward Burns
