As an **energy champion** you will be expected to:

- Promote energy awareness and action.
- Be aware of and support activities such as energy reduction campaigns.
- Share stories to highlight activities undertaken.

As an **energy champion** you will have an option to:

- Run switch off events.
- Participate in energy audits.
- Recruit and mentor other energy champions.
- Record and monitor electricity consumption of equipment.



Opportunities include:

Engagement, awareness and action

- Distribute energy saving tips to colleagues.
- Lead/support/promote an energy reduction campaign.
- Share messages from the Environmental Sustainability Team around energy saving.
- Run/support/promote information sessions on energy related topics.
- Report areas where equipment is consistently left switched on.
- Assign responsibility for switching key pieces of equipment off in an office, a floor or a building.
- Support delivery of the Carbon Management Implementation Programme where appropriate.

Energy monitoring and recording

- Use energy monitors to record electricity consumption of key pieces of equipment and provide recommendations.
- Use timers to ensure equipment is switched off.
- Complete energy audits and share the results with the Environmental Sustainability Team.

General

- Attend the Sustainability Seminar Series.
- Complete 10,000 Actions action plan and return to update it.
- Share stories with the Environmental Sustainability Team to highlight activities undertaken.
