After completing your selection, you must ensure that you have chosen:

- 120 credits overall (including any core courses);
- A minimum of 50 credits per semester;
- A maximum of 70 credits per semester;
- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject (HART/ENGL). If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.

Helpful hints:

- ✓ All courses are 20 credits unless otherwise stated
- ✓ Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester, those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester, and those ending in '0' are taught over both semesters
- ✓ Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes
