

Course Outline: In-sessional Academic Writing (Humanitites)

The second half of this course runs in a block of four weeks during semester two. You can start the course in week 1 or week 5 - see the breakdown below. The blocks are identical so you only need to attend one block. The first three workshops aim to help you write the chapters of a typical dissertation. You will learn more about what is required in each chapter by reading and analysing extracts of academic texts. You will also have the chance to improve your language and writing by completing carefully-targeted practice activities. The final workshop focuses on your writing - you will submit your text to peer review from your classmates. Your tutor will tell you more about this when you start the course.
