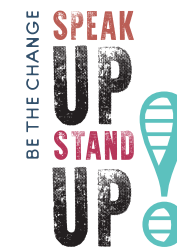


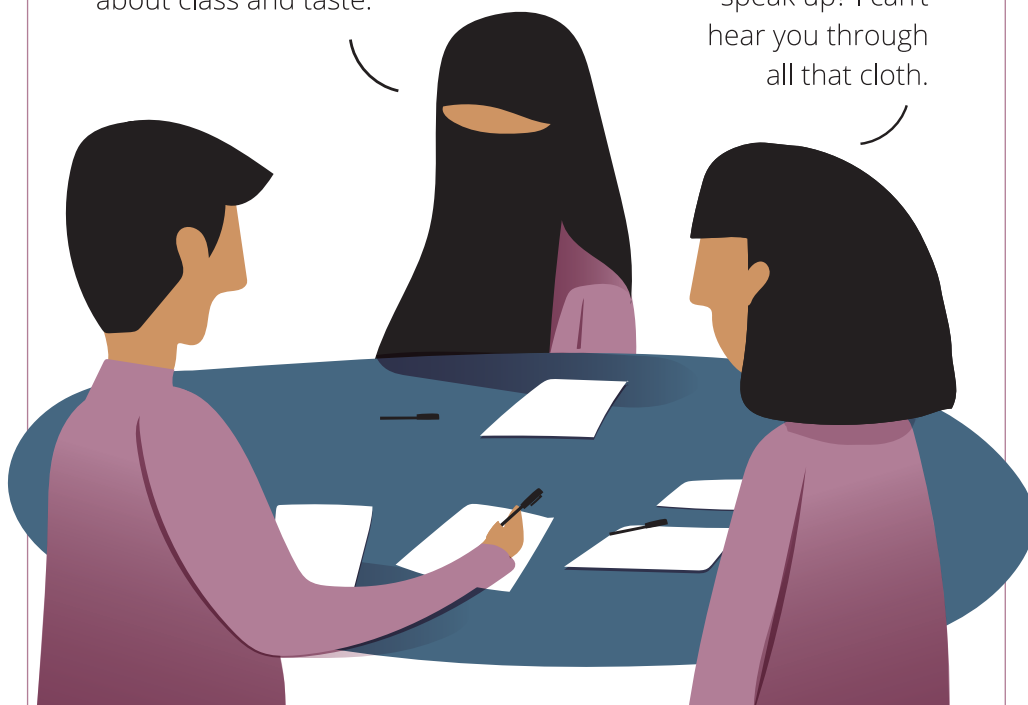
BE THE CHANGE

For God's sake Ghania, can you speak up? I can't hear you through all that cloth.



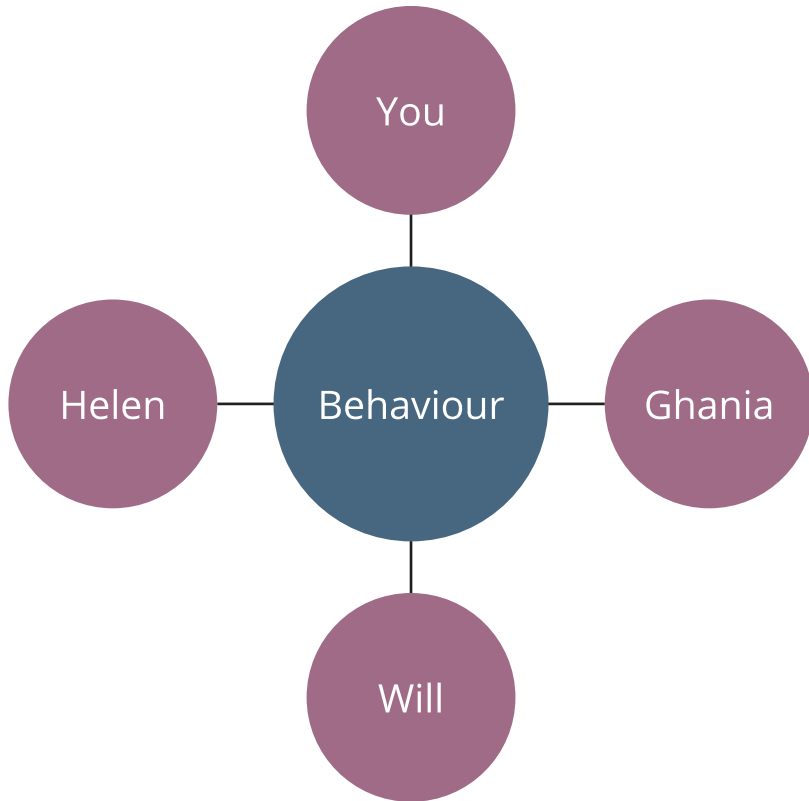
Later you are in the coffee shop with Helen and Will...
