CIRP GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2019

The General Assembly (GA) is the Academy's annual flagship event which serves as an international forum to discuss and disseminate the latest scientific knowledge and technological advancements in production engineering through rigorous peer reviewed research papers (Part 1) and technical presentations covering current projects (Part 2).

The British CIRP delegation have the privilege and honour of hosting the 69th General Assembly in the city of Birmingham, which is the sixth time it will be held in the United Kingdom following London (1958), Nottingham (1968), Harrogate (1983), Edinburgh (1993) and Manchester (2008).





GENERAL ASSEMBLY VENUE

The GA will be held at the International Conference Centre (ICC) situated in the heart of Birmingham with excellent transport links to the city's international airport and a 10 minute walk from the central railway station. Hosting an average of 400 events a year, the purpose-built, world class facility has 10 flexible conference halls equipped with modern audio-visual systems that can be tailored to specific requirements. Furthermore, the venue is within close proximity of the main city attractions including a diverse selection of restaurants, shops, cultural / entertainment centres and hotels.
