Getting there

By train: the nearest station is Manchester Oxford Road which is a short walk away. Manchester Piccadilly is a 20-minute walk away.

By tram: Alight at St Peter's Square, and walk or catch a bus down Oxford Road (around a 15-minute walk away).

By bike: there are a number of Sheffield/<u>hoop</u> stands close to building entrances where cycles can be secured.

By taxi: Taxis can be booked from the main train stations, Piccadilly and Oxford Road and from Manchester Airport – Mantax -0161 230 3333.

By bus: Numerous buses stop nearby on Oxford Road

- Buses from Piccadilly Bus Station: 18, 41, 42, 42A, 42B, 43, 111, 142, 143, 250.
- Buses from Oxford Road Station: All buses that run along Oxford Road, heading out of the city centre.
- Buses from Albert Square: 44, 50, 197, V1, V2.
- Buses from Manchester Airport: 43.
- Bus from Piccadilly Train Station: 147.

Travel by car

All approach routes for cars travelling here are clearly signposted 'The University of Manchester'.

Please note: drivers heading into the city on Oxford Road are no longer able to travel past Hathersage Road between 6am and 9pm, seven days a week. Instead you'll need to reroute, by turning right on to Hathersage Road before continuing your journey along Upper Brook Street.

To accommodate the permanent changes to Oxford Road, Upper Brook Street has been improved to provide drivers with an alternative route. Local access to Oxford Road will be maintained from adjoining roads and signage in place to help everyone navigate the area.

Public car parks;

The Aquatics Centre NCP MSCP, Manchester, M13 9SS (car park B – see the attached campus map) is the nearest public car park to Michael Smith Building (building 71).

- Levels 1 6 are public parking, operated by NCP.
- Opening hours: 0600 2300, 7 days per week
- Public parking tariffs (Levels 1 6): available on the NCP website
- Number of spaces: 400 for public parking;
- Staffed by NCP: 0845 050 7080

There are other public car parks located around the campus, details below;

Car Park D: Booth Street West Car Park, M15 6AR (Access via Higher Cambridge Street)

Travel by air

If you plan to travel by air to The University of Manchester, our nearest airport is Manchester Airport.

Manchester Airport is one of the largest and busiest in the country. It is located about 10 miles (16km) south of the city centre, about 30 minutes from the University. The airport has a number of transport links to the city:

- **Train** The airport's two terminals are linked directly to the city centre by a fast, frequent 24-hour train link to both Piccadilly and Oxford Road stations.
- Taxi A taxi from the airport to the University will cost approximately £20.
- Bus Local buses also run to the Oxford Road campus.
