



On the 10th July 2019 **47** members of staff went to Crosby Beach to undertake a Beach Clean.

We spent **1.5** hours cleaning approximately **200m** of the beach and filled **17** rubbish bags.

We found an average of **916.5 pieces of litter per 100m** which is higher compared to the 2018 UK average of **601 pieces of litter per 100m**.

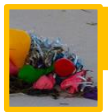
