

Getting from Birmingham New Street station to the ICC / nearby hotels

Arrival into Birmingham New Street station

When travelling by train, you will arrive into one of the 12 platforms at Birmingham New Street station, all of which are below ground level. The platforms are numbered from 1 to 12, with each divided into 2 sides designated A (*eastside*) and B (*westside*). Take the escalator / stairs at either end of the platform or the elevator up to the concourse level of the station. A map of the Birmingham New Street station concourse is shown on Page 2. Please note that automatic ticket barriers are normally in operation especially during busy periods, so remember to keep your tickets in hand in order to pass through the barriers (*remember to take your ticket back as you pass through the barrier*).

Taxi from Birmingham New Street to the ICC and nearby hotels

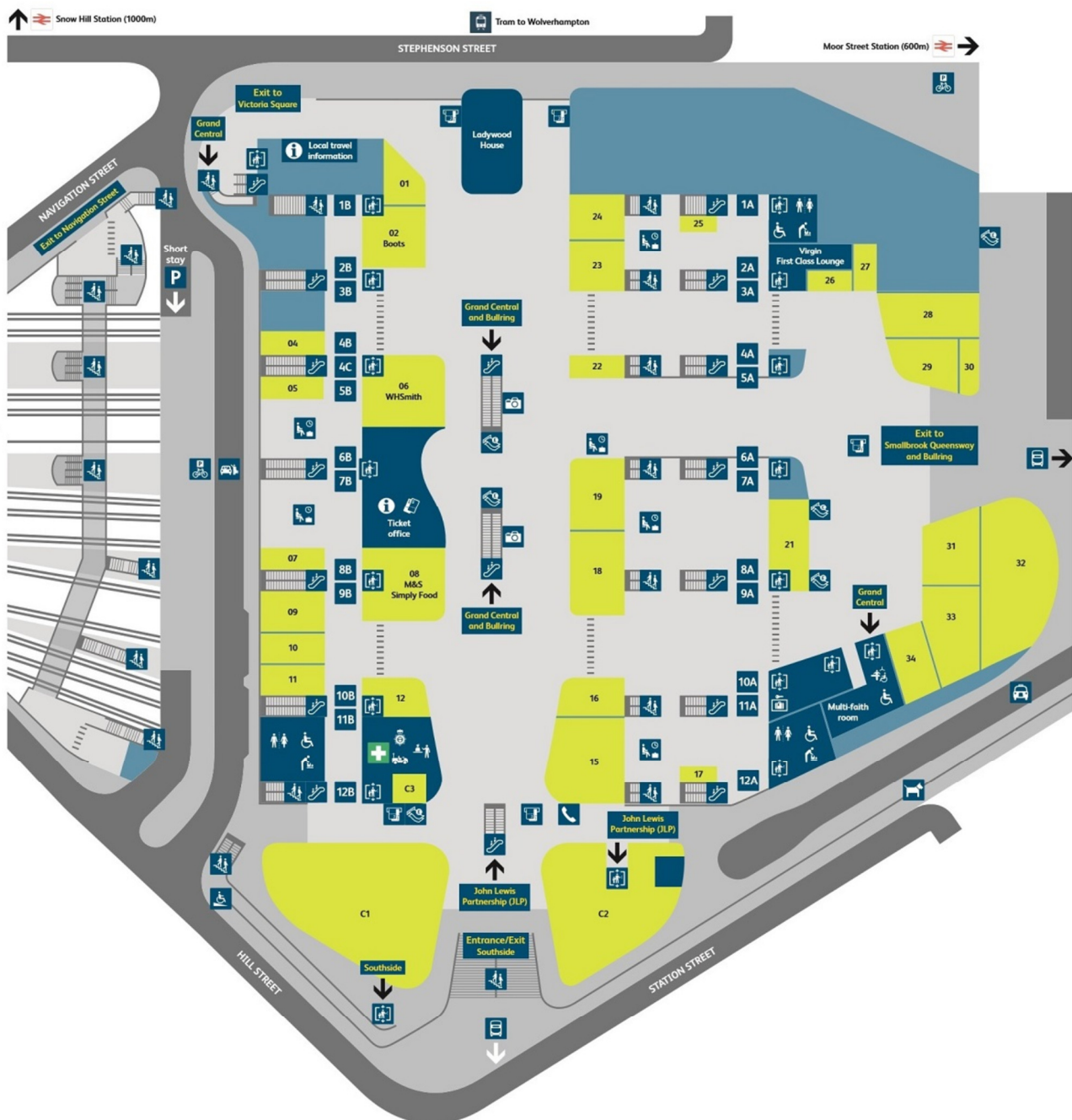
If you wish to take a taxi to the ICC or your hotel, there is a taxi rank right outside the station. Proceed out of the station from the **Smallbrook Quensway and Bullring** exit (there is ample signage in the station) and you will find taxis on your right. The fare to the ICC and nearby hotels (*typically on Broad Street*) will be approximately £5 to £6.

Walking from Birmingham New Street to the ICC and nearby hotels

If you do not mind the short walk to the ICC (*approximately 10 minutes*), head toward the **Victoria Square or Stephenson Street** exit (*there is signage indicating directions in the station*). After exiting the station, see Birmingham city map on Page 3 for recommended route with corresponding directions below:

- i. Cross Stephenson Street (*note there is also a tram line on the road*) and walk a short distance up Temple Street.
- ii. Turn left onto New Street.
- iii. Walk along New Street all the way up to Victoria Square and go around in between the Town Hall and Council House onto Centenary Way (*note that there is currently significant building / construction work along certain parts of this route however there are signs showing directions towards the ICC / Symphony Hall*).
- iv. Continue on Centenary Way which leads out to Centenary Square and the ICC / Symphony Hall is at the end of the square.
- v. The majority of the recommended hotels are within 5 minutes walk from the ICC, primarily along or off Broad Street (*however please check location / address of your hotel*).
