Surface and Depth Block

How to support your ideas Including other writers' ideas effectively in your writing.

How to show what you think Interpreting sources, and showing critical thinking in your texts.

Making Meaning Block

What is the deeper meaning of text?
Understanding how you can create well-structured academic texts,
by looking at the line of argument of each paragraph or chapter.

What exactly do you mean?
In academia, words can have more than one meaning – so here
we look at defining your terms clearly.

Why did something happen?

How to describe the reasons for – often complex – phenomena.

What is the difference?
Showing contrasts and similarities in your writing.
