
For your convenience, please choose the most suitable test centre and date before your registration and payment. Please note that both paper based and PC-based HSK tests are both held at University of Manchester venues.

How can I find my nearest HSK test location?

- (1) Log onto the HSK test service website (<u>www.chinesetest.cn</u>)
- (2) View information about the testing centres on the "Global Testing Centres" page
- (3) Choose the most suitable test centre and date before your registration and payment.



How do I register for HSK and HSKK exams?

PC-based exams registration process:

- (1) Log onto the website (<u>www.chinesetest.cn</u>)
- (2) Sign up by providing necessary personal information including e-mail address, nationality, mother language, birth date etc.
- (3) Test registration. Please select the relevant test centre and date, complete your personal information, upload ID photo and finally confirm your registration information.

Personal information

Please provide name exactly as its displayed on your valid identity document e.g passport or driving license

Photo size requirement

Please note the website photo specifications are strict and must adhere to the following conditions;

- JPG format
- Photo size must be within 100KB
- Standard 'passport style' photo e.g. with face clearly displayed.

What is the difference between paper-based test and PC-based test (IBT test)?

The only difference between the paper-based test and IBT test is:

For the paper-based test answers are submitted with 2B pencils and paper answer sheets, whereas for the IBT test, answers are submitted using a computer, keyboard and mouse.

Both test types require attendance on a specific date and time under standard test invigilation.

Payment

When you successfully sign up for an exam, you will receive an email from the test centre with a payment link and payment deadlines within 3-4 working days.

For paper-based tests, the payment deadline is at least 30 days before the test date.

For PC-based tests, the payment deadline is at least 12 days ahead of the test date.

If payment is not made by the deadline, the registration is incomplete and you will be unable to sit the exam.

Can the test centre be changed after I have completed registration?

If the test fee has not been paid, you can cancel your registration before the deadline and re-register for a new test centre. If the payment has been made, the test centre cannot be changed.

After payment has been made, the test centre will send you a confirmation email to the email address used to register at least 10 days before the test date.

Please contact the test centre if you have any questions or do not receive an email.

How do I access my test admission ticket?

There is more than one way to access your admission ticket;

- 1. Log into your chinesetest.cn profile and print your ticket on the 'Personal Centre' section of the website.
- 2. Visit the test centre to collect your ticket before the exam (you will receive an email regarding available collection times)
- 3. Collect the exam ticket in your exam room on the day of the exam.

For options 1&2, the ticket will usually be available 7-10 days before the test date and you will receive an email confirming this.

When will I will be able to view my test results?

Results for the PC-based test will be available two weeks after the test date. For the paper based exams, results are available after one month.

On the HSK test website, enter the number of your Admission Ticket and name in the "Score" field on the home page and the test score will become visible. Please note that the information you enter must exactly match the information on the Admission Ticket.

When and where can I collect my exam certificate?

You will receive an email when your certificate is available to collect (or receive through the post).

- Paper-based exam certificates will be sent to the test centre approximately 45 days after the test date.
- PC-based exam certificates will be sent to the test centre approximately 30 days after the test date.

If collecting in person, you will be asked to provide your Admission Ticket and valid ID document.
