

Eligibility Criteria for Award of UoM India Scholarship

- Scholarships can only be awarded to offer holders who are domiciled in India
- If a course/programme lasts longer than one year, the scholarships will be offered for the first year of study only
- Scholarships can only be awarded to applicants who studied in India at all levels (school/college/ university) with the exception of students who completed their bachelor's at The University of Manchester and previously studied in India
- Scholarships will be offered at postgraduate taught level only
- Scholarships can only be awarded to applicants who are classified by the University as an international tuition fee payer
- As a condition of the award of a scholarship, recipients are required to take part in student ambassador and/or mentoring schemes
- Scholarships are only available for September 2020 entry (a scholarship award may not be deferred)
- Applicants for scholarships for programmes in the Faculty of Science and Engineering are required to submit a completed application form by 30 April 2020
- Scholarships can only be awarded to applicants who are offer holders on 30 April 2020

Selection Criteria for Award of UoM India Scholarship

- Academic excellence over and above the criteria required for admission to the PGT programme selected
- Proficiency in English language
- Additionally, the scholarships may be distributed across The University of Manchester PGT programmes to reflect our range of strategic teaching priorities
