Project Outline

Policy@Manchester have been working closely with UoM academics to support evidence based policy making around the environment agenda, including use of plastics, clean air and carbon reduction.

In this internship, the student will have the opportunity to work with the team to support the launch of their new publication and source data to support a number of the policy asks within the new publication and produce in a format that is appealing to our policy makers. Working with our data they will use a combination of web-scraping and data mining techniques to assemble the required information, with input from online parliamentary data sources and assistance from the Policy@Manchester team.
