Project Outline

Each year, IPPR North publish an annual State of the North Report which provides an in depth look at the key policy theme affecting the North of England (North West, Yorkshire and Humber and North East). Previous themes have included devolution, economic resilience and northern powerhouse. This year, the theme will be an examination of the Government's 'Levelling up' agenda. The report will examine the key data for social inclusion in the North including education, health, income and poverty and assess the degree to which the Government's proposals for 'levelling up' will have an impact. Based on the data, the report will also put forward additional proposals for 'levelling up' in the North.
