Application Criteria

Essential

- Strong interest in domestic abuse, intimate partner violence and gender-based violence
- Interest in the work that Respect does
- Self-motivated with good time management skills
- Excellent analytical and research skills
- Ability to critically engage with quantitative data, understanding the strengths and limitations of it
- Ability to formulate different narratives based on the data analysis and identify the most realistic one
- Understanding of different ways to collate, measure and communicate impact
- Good writing skills and interest in communications
- Willingness to work collaboratively with practitioners

Desirable

- Knowledge of the research terrain on domestic and intimate partner violence, particularly the debates about the connection between gender and intimate partner violence, or willingness and ability to understand and work with the complexity
- Interest in and knowledge of communications particularly around social, political and economic issues.

- This project would offer the opportunity to present findings to the Respect board-subcommittee, the Influence Group.
- It offers the opportunity to write up the findings into a briefing paper for possible publication by Respect (naming the placement holder as author or co-author as relevant).
- There would be the potential to present findings at the next national Respect conference either as a conference keynote or workshop presentation or at another Respect event.
