The post-qualification Professional Doctorate in Forensic Psychology programme aims to provide you with the opportunity to:

- systematically acquire and understand a substantial body of knowledge which is at the core of forensic psychology;
- conceptualise, design and implement a project for the generation of new knowledge, applications or understanding at the forefront of the discipline;
- develop the qualities and transferable skills necessary for employment requiring the exercise of personal responsibility and largely autonomous initiative in complex and unpredictable situations in professional environments.

Programme learning outcomes

At the end of the DForenPsy programme, successful graduates are expected to be able to:

- make informed judgements on complex issues in the specialist field of forensic psychology;
- communicate ideas and conclusions clearly and effectively to specialist and non-specialist audiences;

- demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of applicable techniques for research and advanced academic enquiry.
