## What will happen next?

The University of Manchester will contact you via email to provide you with a detailed list of the documents we require for your application.

2

You will be required to send copies of your up-to-date academic transcript and English language certificate to [ug.biosciences@manchester.ac.uk](mailto:ug.biosciences@manchester.ac.uk)

You will receive acknowledgement emails from UCAS and The University of Manchester.

You will be contacted again by the University once it is time to select the units you'd like to study on your course with us. At this point, you will also receive detailed information about settling in, accommodation and the support available to you at Manchester.

If successful, you will receive an offer through UCAS.

You will be interviewed by a member of staff from The University of Manchester. This may be via Skype or a representative in your country.

## Fees

Tuition fees cover the cost of your study and include charges for registration, tuition, supervision, examinations and graduation.

Payment of fees will also entitle you to membership of the library, the Students' Union and the Athletic Union.

You will pay the standard international fees for your course each year you are with us.
