I originally used <u>Ethnologue</u> to compile the data a couple of years ago – however, their data is now only available on a subscription basis


This <u>World Populations Review page</u> is useful and the <u>2013 British Council publication "The English Effect"</u> supports the data of 25% of the world's population speaking English
