FREE CHOICE COURSE UNITS

You may apply to take 20 units of free choice units and this is the optimum stage at which to select a free choice unit. It is important that you find out for yourself the attendance and examination requirements of the unit concerned.

Please ensure that you choose a course from the correct year. You can tell which year and semester courses are from their code e.g. POLI20521 – the first digit indicates which year the course is – 2nd year; and the last digit indicates which semester the course is running in – semester 1. It may be possible to select a course from a year below outside of Politics but this requires specific approval.

In order to choose a free choice unit you must contact the BSocSc Politics and International Relations Programme Director to seek approval.

LANGUAGE COURSES (LEAP)

If you wish to sign up for a language course, you will be allocated according to the level you have already attained – beginner, intermediate, advanced.

Please note that if you have NOT studied a language course in the previous academic year you may need to obtain permission from the Programme Director before you can enrol on the course.

NB: Final year students cannot select a beginners' language course as their free choice.
