

- Offer letter and information

Fees

- Fee level for your course appears on your offer letter
- Standard fixed-fees for 2010/11:

Arts/ non-lab based: £ 11, 300

Science & Engineering: £ 14, 200

Standard clinical: £ 25, 900

NB There are some important exceptions to these bands Fees can be paid in advance, at registration or in instalments by direct debit

Living costs:

UG courses (9 months) £7,480

PG courses (12 months) £9,600

 Living costs – this should cover accommodation, meals, books, stationary, clothes, local transport

Pre-payment of fees before mid September:

- Contact with your full name, student ID number and the amount you want to pay
- Please allow up to 48 hours for a reply during busy times

Payment at registration:

- Over the telephone +44 161 275 5000 by credit/debit card. A credit card hotline will go live from 1st September
- Cash
- Credit card or Direct debit (requires a UK account)
- Cheque (drawn on a UK account)
- Bankers' draft (in Sterling)

Applying for Accommodation

- Submit application form as soon as you have accepted a place (Conditional or Unconditional) on a course at the University
- Applications are processed on a 'first come, first served' basis.
 Deadline 31 August 2010
- En-suite accommodation is in high demand: apply early to avoid disappointment
- Follow the accommodation instructions carefully: you will receive a contract in electronic format, and will need to sign it, and send it back with the deposit payment within 7 days or receiving the email

- Use 'Keep My Place' message service to extend the deadline to return your contract
