

Access to HE Award

Background

The University of Manchester is committed to encouraging local students following Access to Higher Education programmes of study to apply to its undergraduate courses. A £1,750 per annum non-repayable scholarship is available for 2011 entry to all home students ordinarily resident in one of the ten boroughs of Greater Manchester. We would expect you to have been resident in Greater Manchester for a period of at least 12 months prior to the commencement of your studies.

Eligibility

Applicants must have followed an "Access to Higher Education" Programme, (All Access to HE programmes which are approved under the QAA Recognition Scheme .ie recognised courses in England, Wales and Northern Ireland are listed on the UCAS Access Courses database at <u>www.ucas.ac.uk</u>) and been accepted onto a University undergraduate programme of study (please note that this *excludes* programmes of study where there is other non means tested public funding available e.g. Diploma Nursing and Social Work). Further details of programmes excluded from the scheme are provided on the application form (section 17). Applicants must be considered to be home students for the purpose of fees i.e. been ordinarily resident in the UK throughout the three years immediately preceding this application.

Closing date

To guarantee that the award is in place in time for the first scheduled payment date, applications must be submitted by 31st August 2011. However, applications will still be accepted beyond this date.

Payment of the award:

Eligible students will receive an award of £1,750 per annum payable in each academic year. Payments will be made in instalments which follow the schedule of other University Bursaries.
