## **Key Transitions During the Student Life Cycle**

Articulating generic transition points is intended to encourage awareness of the points at which students may be vulnerable, enabling performance and attendance at key times to be monitored. Schools are encouraged to use the 'Key Transitions' as a foundation for their own analysis of transitions within their discipline/programmes of study. For example, where students take part in a placement as part of their programme, consideration should be given to issues surrounding their choice of placement, departure, contact whilst away, and return. Some disciplines routinely *viva* final year undergraduates as part of the assessment process and would wish to consider this as a transition point.
