PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- Minimum of 50 credits per semester ;
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester;
- **Please note that, in addition to the courses listed below, you will be enrolled on the following course units; SALC11230 -SALC Health & Safety Induction, SALC11250- SALC Wellbeing and Diversity and SALC11260- SALC Academic Malpractice.**

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. AHCP30000. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
