The School of Arts, Languages and Cultures is organising the third annual conference in the 'Innovative language teaching and learning at university' series. Following great success in Newcastle (2011) and Bristol (2012), this year's one day event will be focussing on student engagement.

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We welcome papers on any past and present projects or case studies focusing on innovative ways to enhance student engagement in languages at university. We would be particularly interested in the following broad areas:
