### PLEASE NOTE:

- Maximum of 70 credits per semester

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. AHCP30000. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
