PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- Minimum 100 credits must be Level 2
- Maximum 20 credits at Level 1 or 3
- Please note that Level 2 Philosophy units normally require you to have a pre-requisite of at least 20 credits taken within the Philosophy Dept at Level 1

HELPFUL HINT:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
