6. Free Choice Courses

Free choice – if you have not yet registered for 120 credits, you can select up to 40 credits of free choice units.

Please note:

- A maximum of 20 credits can be taken at one level below your current level of study.
- A maximum of 20 credits can be taken as free choice outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures.
- If you take course units outside of music as free choice, the staff teaching them will not be aware of RNCM and University priority days. Therefore, you are advised to choose courses that are scheduled on University priority days (Monday, Wednesday am, Friday am) where possible, to minimise the risk of scheduling conflicts with the RNCM.
