Please note when choosing the course units you wish to take you must ensure you choose:

- A minimum of 50 credits per semester
- A maximum of 70 credits per semester
- 120 credits overall (including any core courses)
- No more or no less credits as stated from each list
- No more than 20 credits from the lower level
- All students must take a minimum of 20 credits' essay-based courses from within Music

Helpful hints:

- Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester, those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester, and those ending in '0' are usually taught over both semesters
- Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes

3. Free Choice Courses

If you have not taken a Minor, and you have not yet registered for 120 credits, you can select up to 20 credits of free choice units. Students will normally be limited to 20 credits of free-choice options outside of Music, although 40 credits may be allowed with the approval of the Programme Director with the condition that no more than 20 credits may be taken outside of SALC.

Please note:

- A maximum of 20 credits can be taken at one level below your current level of study.
- Any Level 2 Music units taken will count towards your Free Choice allowance.
- Students cannot opt for Ensemble A or B if they have already completed 20 credits (in either or both strands) during their second year.
