Please note when choosing the course units you wish to take you must ensure you choose:

- A minimum of 50 credits per semester
- A maximum of 70 credits per semester
- 120 credits overall (including any core courses)
- No more or no less credits as stated from each list
- No more than 20 credits from the lower level
- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject. If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.
- A maximum of 20 credits free choice units
- All students must take a minimum of 20 credits' essay-based courses

Helpful hints:

- Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester, those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester, and those ending in '0' are usually taught over both semesters
- Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes
- Please note that 40-credit practice units (Drama) take place in one semester, often over several full days of timetabled teaching. They are a significant time commitment, and selecting one will restrict your other options.
- In Drama lists, Theatre-based units are marked with (T), and Film based units with (F).

6. Free Choice Courses
