**Please note:**

You have two compulsory course units totalling 40 credits. You make up the remaining 80 credits by choosing four optional course units. You may, if you wish, substitute 40 of those 80 credits with free-choice course unit(s).

You may take up to 20 credits of course units at a first year level.

You may **not** take any credits of course units at a third year level.

Ideally, you should have 60 credits in each semester, but when choosing the optional 80 credits you wish to take, you must ensure:

- you have no fewer than 50 credits in either semester;
- you have no more than 70 credits in either semester;
- you have checked timetable details to ensure that you do not have any clashes;
- you must ensure that you have chosen 120 credits in total, even if you are spending all or part of Year 2 on the Worldwide or Erasmus Exchange Programmes
