Please note:

You have one compulsory course unit totalling 20 credits. You make up the remaining 100 credits by choosing five optional course units. You may, if you wish, substitute 20 of those 100 credits with a free-choice course unit(s).

You may take up to 20 credits of course units at a first year level.

You may **not** take any credits of course units at a third year level.

Ideally, you should have 60 credits in each semester, but when choosing the optional 100 credits you wish to take, you must ensure:

- you have no fewer than 50 credits in either semester;
- you have no more than 70 credits in either semester;
- **you have a minimum of 40 credits in both American Studies and English Literature, but no more than 80 credits in either subject;**
- you have checked timetable details to ensure that you do not have any clashes;
- you must ensure that you have chosen 120 credits in total, even if you are spending all or part of Year 2 on the Worldwide or Erasmus Exchange Programmes
- NB: Places on Creative Writing course units (i.e. Fiction and Poetry) are allocated by competition. Students interested in taking one of these units will be invited to submit a sample of their writing through an email from the office in spring.
