PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- **Maximum 20 credits at Level 1**

- Please check timetable details for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes!

HELPFUL HINT:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code e.g. CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1, and '2' indicates Semester 2.
