PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- All courses are 20 credits unless stated otherwise
- **Maximum 20 credits at Level 2**
- We would encourage you to discuss your course options with your Academic Adviser
- Please check timetable details for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes!

HELPFUL HINT:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code: e.g. CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1, and '2' indicates Semester 2.
- To enrol on any of the course units outlined in your programme regulation use the Self Service area of Campus Solutions.

Step 2: You may take **up to 20 credits of level 2 LELA** units that you did not take in the second year. You should note however the overall requirement that **no more than 20 credits may be taken at level 2**, so that it is not permitted, in particular, to take this option in addition to taking a 20-credit free-choice or language option at level 2.
