PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- Minimum 100 credits must be Level 3
- Students should note that the minimum Japanese Studies content at level 2 is one designated (content) 20 credit course in addition to language (40 credits or 20 credits in the case of SOLO).
- Joint Hons students may take up to a maximum of 20 credits (free choice) outside of the two named subject areas, subject to approval by the relevant Programme Director

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2

5: Free Choice Course Units: Subject to the approval of the relevant Programme Director, Joint Honours students at Level 2 may take up to 20 credits as free choice providing the steps above have been fulfilled. You can find the full list from the Courses Tab within My Manchester login.manchester.ac.uk

PLEASE NOTE - when selecting your free choice course unit:

- That the course unit is at Level 2 or Level 3, with the following exception:
 - You may take a maximum 20 credits at Level 1 within your named subject areas.
- LEAP course units (apply directly through the LEAP office) may only be taken at Level 2 or Level 3 (provided that no more than three languages are studied in any one year), with the following exception:
 - You may take Level 1 LEAP Korean in your second year as your 20 credits of free choice; if this option is chosen in Year 2, then in your final year you may continue with the study of Korean at Level 2.
- Only the 10-credit LEAP Tandem course unit running in semester 1 is permitted in ONE of your named languages in second year.
