PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- **120 credits overall** (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- **Minimum 100 credits must be Level 2**
- **Maximum 20 credits at Level 1**

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Students in MLBM French may take up to 20 credits per year out of the total of 120 as a free choice from course units within the Faculty of Humanities, provided that the required number of credits is taken in their MLBM programme. This may include one LEAP language unit (20 credits) in either or both of the second and final years, as long as in any one year no more than three languages are studied. However, a LEAP language unit may only be taken as a free choice unit in the final year if a prerequisite LEAP unit in the SAME language has been taken in the second year.
- In order to progress to the third year of the programme, it is necessary to pass your compulsory core language unit with a mark of 40 or above. It is also necessary to pass at least 60 more credits with a mark of 40 or above, and a further 40 credits with a mark of 30 or above. You must pass at least 40 credits at the first attempt (i.e. not through resits). Please see your School Handbook for more information.

HELPFUL HINT:

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
- ✓ To enrol on any of the course units outlined in your programme regulation use the Self Service area of Campus Solutions

Important Notes

- **At least 100 of the total of 120 credits must be at Level 2 (i.e. course units whose code numbers begin with the number 2, e.g. BMAN22000), but up to 20 of these credits can be at Level 1.** MLBM French students may therefore choose one or two of the following (provided that all their other credits are at Level 2):
 - Semester 1:
 - BMAN10621** (10 credits) Fundamentals of Financial Reporting
 - MCEL10010** (10 credits) Entrepreneurial Skills (a)
 - Semester 2:
 - BMAN10632** (10 credits) Fundamentals of Management Accounting (prerequisite: BMAN10621) – this is a prerequisite for BMAN21040 which can then be taken in the final year.
 - MCEL10012** (10 credits) Entrepreneurial Skills (b)
- **No more than ONE** of the following units may be taken during your MLBM programme: BMAN20022 Career Development, CARS22012 Career Management Skills, SALC20401 Careers & Project Management for Arts, Languages and Cultures, SALC20402 Careers & Project Management for Arts, Languages and Cultures.
- Note that only ONE of UCOL20021/UCOL20022 Leadership in Action (10 credits) and UCOL20020 Leadership in Action (20 credits) may be chosen, **but not both**. The same applies to MCEL30001 and MCEL30002 (Tools and Techniques for Enterprise).
- **Please note that asterisked course units have prerequisites and it is your responsibility to ensure that you meet these requirements before embarking on one of these course units. Also, some final year units have prerequisites and you are advised to plan ahead to ensure that you take the prerequisites for any final year units you wish to take. Most units with prerequisites are either Accounting and Finance units or Economics units – please refer to the separate guides about those units for more information about prerequisites.**
