3: Free Choice Course Units: Subject to the approval of the relevant Programme Director, Joint Honours students at Level 3 may take up to 20 credits as free choice providing the steps above have been fulfilled. PLEASE NOTE - when selecting your free choice course unit:

- That the course unit is at Level 3, with the following exception:
 - You may take a maximum 20 credits at Level 2 within your named subject areas or from University College units (codes prefixed with UCOL). Please note, if you have already chosen a Level 2 unit in one of the previous steps, you can only choose a Level 3 unit as free choice.
- LEAP course units may only be taken at the current level of study (provided that no more than three languages are studied in any one year) and must be applied for directly with the LEAP office.
- Tandem LEAP course unit is NOT permitted in the final year.
