  - o Please note where a UCOL unit is a language unit (e.g. Arabic and Mandarin) the LEAP rules below apply.
- For subject areas elsewhere in the University, the course unit must be at Level 3.
- LEAP course units must be at Level 3 (provided that no more than three languages are studied in any one year) and must be applied for directly with the LEAP office.
  - Tandem LEAP course unit is NOT permitted in the final year except by the recommendation of the Residence Abroad and Exchange Committee.
