Induction is a process that continues throughout a student's relationship with the University, **through which they are offered the information, support and networks that will give them the best opportunity to develop** into graduates 'distinguished by their intellectual capabilities, employability, leadership qualities, and their ability and ambition to contribute to society.'

(Manchester 2020: the Strategic Plan)

Objectives of Induction

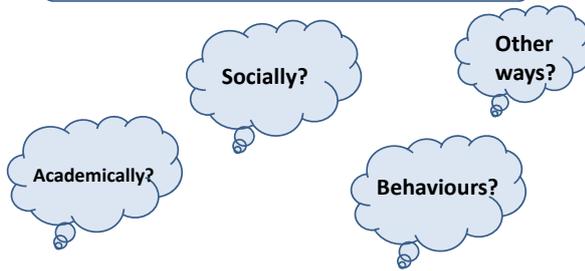
- So far:

Stages of Induction

- We are suggesting that Induction can be treated in a series of stages:
 - Pre-Arrival
 - Initial Welcome (covered by the Manchester Welcome and School Welcomes)
 - First Year
 - Subsequent Years – annual transitions
 - Preparation for graduation

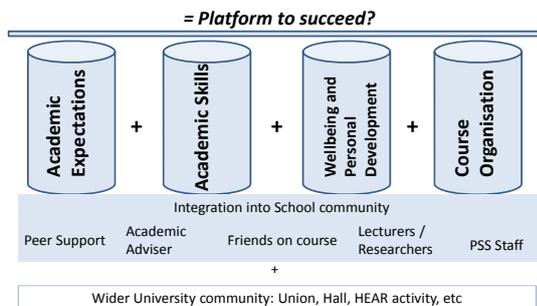

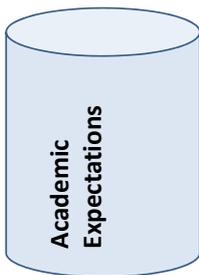

What do students need to be introduced to?

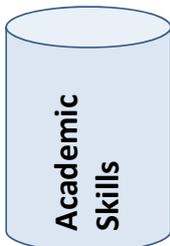
When do they need this information?

Does it need **repeating** at any point in their academic career?

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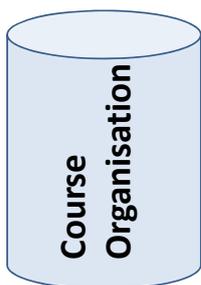
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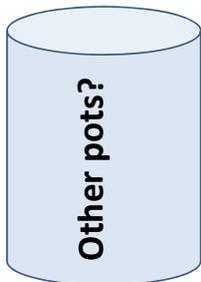
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Monitoring/Evaluation/Governance

 - What should the mechanisms be for ongoing monitoring/evaluation/review?
 - How will students be involved in all the above?
