PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core units)
- 60 credits in each semester (you may not take more than 70 credits in a single semester).
- You may only select units designed for level 1 students (course codes beginning with a '1'). In exceptional circumstances it may be possible to select up to 20 credits of UCIL-coded units with a course code beginning with a '2'. You must obtain approval for the Undergraduate Programmes Director if you wish to do this.

Particular programme guidelines:

- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject. If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.
- Should you wish to do a PGCE secondary course in English and Drama after your degree, you are advised to take an equal number of credits in both subjects, not doing so may affect your ability to study certain PGCE programmes.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
- ✓ Please check the timetable for courses that you choose to ensure that there are not any clashes.
