### **Please note:**

You have five core course units totalling 100 credits in your first year. You must choose 20 credits more by following the steps outlined below. In total, you must take 120 credits across the full academic year.

When choosing the course units you wish to take, you must ensure that:

- you have a minimum of 50 credits in either semester;
- you have a maximum of 70 credits in either semester;
- you have only selected first year course units. You may **not** take any second or third year course units.

You will be automatically enrolled onto the following course units by your Programme Administrator. You will be dropped from ENGL10051 at a later date if you opt to take a flexible honours pathway.

## Choose a Minor in Digital Humanities

As a single honours student in SALC you have the option to study the minor in Digital Humanities. Taking this minor allows you to explore the subject area, whilst still allowing you to complete your single honours degree. At the end of the first year, you can choose to continue with the minor in years two and three, and have the subject feature in your degree title if you wish. Alternatively, if you decide to drop the minor, you can still make use of free choice credits in years two and three.
