## **PLEASE NOTE:**

When choosing the preferred optional course units you wish to take you must ensure you select:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- 60 credits in each subject area
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester

## **HELPFUL HINTS:**

- ✓ All courses are 20 credits unless stated otherwise
- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2

STEP 1: Students with AS-Level grade B or above in Japanese (or its equivalent) must take:	Credit

AND EITHER	<u> </u>
EALC10122 Introduction to Modern Japanese Society	20
OR	
EALC10111 Introduction to Japanese History and Culture	20

STEP 2: Students who are beginners in Japanese must take:	Credit
EALC10080 Japanese Language and Linguistics I	60
