PLEASE NOTE:

When choosing the preferred optional course units you wish to take you must ensure you select:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester

HELPFUL HINTS:

- ✓ All courses are 20 credits unless stated otherwise
- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
